Orion the hunter of stars has risen. It is snowing. The night grows quiet. As we cross the frozen stream

trees breathes the fragrance of incense.
The moon shines out from the eyes of the wild beasts.
The hare is dancing, his coat grown snowy-white.
The deer with his branching antlers dreams in the thickets. The owl shrieks.
Once long ago the wolf howled in our forest
And the scream of the mountain cat was heard through the woods.

Sometimes I cannot think what to do. Then I walk in the woods.
Let us sit for a while and watch the journey of the stars.

I know that life is not fair. I feel it to be so and it makes me angry.
